The representatives from the City of Indiaonla detailed the neighborhood access to the Summerset Trail they are requesting north of Hillcrest Street. The area was an access for the City to check a sewage lift station. The station is being taken out of use and the City wishes to install a neighborhood access on the existing drive.

Ron Miller moved to approve the request from the City of Indianola to install a neighborhood access north of Hillcrest Street. Sue Boll seconded. Motion carried by unanimous vote.
